A Minute with Jesus: Jesus came into the world so that we might know God's love. It is deeply moving to read these words from Scripture: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). During this holy season of Advent, we want to take time to ponder the meaning of Christmas, as proof of God's love for us. The Nativity of Our Lord celebrates the point in history when the Son of God took on human flesh for our Salvation — an act of loving obedience to the Father, and saving love for us, in order to offer Himself for us on the Cross, and now, give Himself to us in the Holy Eucharist. Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Heavenly Father, help me to realize how much You love me in that You sent Your Son on the first Christmas as my Savior. This week, read how the Angel Gabriel announced to Mary that She would be the Mother of our Savior in Luke 1:26-38.


