

A Minute with Jesus: Jesus is truly present in the Holy Eucharist

When we look at the consecrated Host at Mass, we see only bread, but the reality is we are looking at Jesus truly present. We may ask Jesus to grant us the grace to believe this truth, that though "hidden", He is truly present in holy Communion. It is important to remember that what we are not able to see with our eyes, we grasp by choosing to believe, with faith's consent. Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Lord, I want to believe. Please help me believe what You say is true, especially helping the part of me that sometimes

questions.

This week, read about the father of a sick boy who asked Jesus to help him believe what seemed impossible in Mark 9:20-27.
